6. Spoken English+Storytelling

Spoken English + Storytelling + Phonetics Course (Ages 5–8)

Objectives:

- Build foundational spoken English and vocabulary.
- Introduce phonetics through games and visual aids.
- Teach basic greetings, self-introduction, and question formation.
- Encourage expression through storytelling and description.
- Develop confidence in speaking using fun, interactive methods.

Course Highlights:

- Phonics Foundation: Introduction to vowels and consonants using games like sound bingo, flashcards, and matching.
- Everyday English: Greetings, small talk, introductions, talking about weather, emotions, and object description.
- Basic Grammar: Focus on nouns, verbs, adjectives, pronouns, prepositions.
- Storytelling Basics: Identifying story elements (characters, setting, plot), creating characters, building simple plots, and group storytelling.
- Activities and Tools: Role plays, puppets, “I Spy”, drawing, games like charades and obstacle courses.
- Soft Skills: Active listening, polite speech, non-verbal communication, and confidence-building.

Spoken English + Storytelling + Idioms Course (Ages 9–14)

Objectives:

- Enhance fluency and grammar for real-world communication.
- Build vocabulary and introduce idioms and figurative language.
- Deepen storytelling through structured plot development.
- Boost public speaking and presentation skills.

Course Highlights:

- Advanced Conversational English: Differentiating formal/informal speech, interviews, opinions, debates, small talk.
- Idioms and Figurative Language: Thematic idioms (emotions, time, food, animals), idiom games, creative writing using idioms.
- Grammar for Storytelling: Verb tenses, sentence types, descriptive language, connectors, direct/indirect speech.
- Storytelling Techniques: Character development with depth, vivid setting creation, plot structure analysis, realistic dialogue writing, planning stories.
- Interactive Learning: Speed networking games, comic strip creation, debates, story retelling, writing exercises, and group projects.
- Presentation & Communication Skills: Confidence-building, non-verbal cues, active listening, and story sharing.

Dainik Prarthana (Daily Prayers)

Lakshmi rests at the tip of hand (i.e. palm), who we worship for wealth. Saraswati rests in the middle of the hand, who we worship for knowledge. And Govind is at the base of our hand, who we worship for health and protection.

We should look at our palm every morning, and chant the mantra contemplating on them.

- Origin: Vishnu Purana

(Oh Mother Earth) O Devi, you who have the Ocean as your Garments, and Mountains as your Bosom, O Consort of Lord Vishnu, salutations to you. Please forgive the touch of my feet (on Earth, which is Your Holy Body).

This is to be chanted when our feet touches the ground in the morning.

O rivers Ganga, Yamuna, Godavari, Saraswati, Narmada, Sindhu and Kaveri, please enrich the water I am bathing with, with your presence.

Salutations to Devi Saraswati, Giver of Boons and Fulfiller of Wishes. O Devi, when I begin my studies, please bestow on me the capacity of Right Understanding, always.

The instrument, the object, the doer and the act - of offering are all brahma; (one who considers thus) state of brahma alone is the destination worthy of such who is steadfast in such selfless deeds.
